# CHOIR ACTIVITIES ON HOLD / SUMMER EVENTS -**CANCELLED**

As you will know, our weekly choir meeting is currently suspended because of the Coronavirus pandemic. Our last session was held on Monday 9th March 2020. However, the Committee is still able to communicate by email and is continuing to make plans for the year ahead.

The Spring concert of Mozart music due to take place on 16th May 2020 has had to be cancelled, and the Committee has been in touch with the external soloists and orchestra to cancel their bookings. They are self employed musicians and we understand that all their bookings for the next few months have been cancelled because of the pandemic, impacting on their means of income. We hope that they will benefit from the Government's rescue plan for the self employed.

The High Tea with Song planned for Monday 22nd June 2020 has also been cancelled.

Thank you to all those choir members who returned their four pieces of music by Mozart to David's house on 23 March. For those who were away or unable to return their music on 23rd, the Librarians will be in touch with you individually about this. It is important that ALL your music is returned to the Librarian so that it can be returned to the Music Library in good time and not incur a fine!

Looking ahead, we hope that the choir will be able to start up again in early September. Watch this space! In the meantime, we hope that you all keep safe and well over the next few weeks.

## **AUTUMN 2020 - THE CHOIR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

Assuming that the Coronavirus restrictions have been lifted and the choir is able to meet again in September, the AGM will take place on Monday 7th September 2020 at 7pm at Christchurch, Clarendon Park Road. The agenda and other AGM papers will be sent to paid up members in due course.
