UPDATE ON FUTURE CHOIR ACTIVITIES

It is quite a while since the last newsletter was issued in April 2020 - and so this update is long overdue! Although the Choir was not able to meet for most of 2020 due to the pandemic, the Choir Committee was still able to meet regularly on Zoom in order to plan for when we are able to reconvene. The Government's vaccination programme and its plans for easing lockdown restrictions seem to be on track and going well. In view of this, the Committee is very hopeful that the choir will be able to restart in the summer. So, here are two dates for your diaries:

- 1. Subject to the relaxing of Covid restrictions, the first event will be the Bob Chilcott Singing Day on Saturday 31 July 2021; and then,
- 2. Following that, we hope that the choir will be able to recommence regular rehearsals on Monday 6 September 2021. In the meantime, we hope that you all keep safe and well over the next few weeks.

Bob Chilcott Singing Day - Saturday 31st July 2021

A Singing Day led by Bob Chilcott was arranged for last summer but is now planned for Saturday 31 July 2021. Bob Chilcott is a British choral composer, conductor and singer; and was a member of the King's Singers from 1985 to 1997, singing tenor. The Singing Day will be open to both choir members and others who enjoy singing. Please put the date in your diary as it will be our first opportunity to sing together again since the start of the pandemic!

Venue: the Singing Day will be at Christchurch on Clarendon Park Road. The venue given previously (St John's Church on Clarendon Park Road) is no longer available.

AUTUMN 2021 - THE CHOIR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Assuming that the choir is able to meet again in September, the AGM will take place on **Monday 6th September 2021 at 7pm** at Christchurch, Clarendon Park Road. The agenda and other AGM papers will be sent to paid up members later in May.

All the Committee positions of Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary, Concert Secretary, Librarian, Assistant Librarian & Wardrobe Mistress will become vacant at the AGM. Some of the existing post holders may decide to stand for re-election, but it is open to all other choir members to stand as well. We encourage any singer to offer to help and stand as a Committee member.

After the AGM, we will begin rehearsals for the Autumn Concert on Saturday 13th November 2021.
